SOUTH32 COMMUNITY GRANTS AWARDED, NEXT GRANT CYCLE OPEN THROUGH MAY 29

The South32 Hermosa Community Fund is accepting new grant applications from Santa Cruz County non-profits through May 29 for its current grant cycle. The fund, which is held by the Community Foundation for Southern Arizona (CFSA), supports non-profit groups working to improve education, environment, health and welfare, recreation, civic enhancement, and arts, culture and history in the county, in accordance with the community's needs and priorities.
